Course title: Spanish DELE B1 exam preparation course

Course descriptor/objectives

This course is focussed on developing oral and written comprehension and expression in order to facilitate success in the DELE B1 exam.

Students will practise the fours skills and will get used to the methodology of the exam with an accredited examiner. Participants will be asked to complete exercises at home every week to consolidate their progress in class.

This Diploma accredits language users' capacity to:

- Understand the main points of texts spoken and written in standard varieties of Spanish, provided that they involve wellknown topics related to work, studies or everyday life.
- 2. Deal with most situations and contexts involving these uses.
- Produce simple, coherent texts about wellknown topics or issues of personal interest, such as describing experiences, events, wishes, plans, and aspirations, or expressing opinions.

Language-specific information:

Spanning four continents, with official language status in twenty countries, Spanish native speakers number more than 500 million. Considered a global language, it is the second-most-spoken native language after Mandarin Chinese. As part of the romance language family, Spanish can trace its roots

back to the Latin of the roman empire, meaning it shares certain features and vocabulary with French and Italian, among others. Proficiency in Spanish can unlock vast areas of culture and history, including classic works like Don Quixote by Cervantes, and more modern media, with a huge selection of Spanish film and television available online. In fact, after English and Chinese, Spanish is the third most common language on the internet.

Prerequisite:

This non-credit bearing weekly course is intended for language learners who are <u>already working at B1</u> level.

Technical requirements:

- -PC, laptop or tablet with camera and microphone
- -Stable internet connection

Delivery will be via Zoom or Microsoft Teams
